French Seek a Less Expensive Place for Riffian's Exile.

PARIS, July 31 (P).-Although the French Government some time ago decided to exile to Reunion Island Abdel Krim, the surrendered Riffian war chief, it is possible that he will be sent elsewhere.

Resident General Steeg and Minister of Colonies Perrier are discussing the best place to keep the Riffian chieftain at the smallest expense to France and at the same time out of mischief.

The Government has definitely decided to exile him to a French possession in the Indian Ocean, but whether it will be Madagascar, Reunion or another place has not been settled. M. Steeg does not expect to leave for Morocco for two weeks, and a decision probably will be reached just before his departure.
