

Riffian Attacks Intensified.

FEZ, Morocco, June 11 (AP).—The situation in general in the French zone in Morocco where the French troops are in conflict with the rebel tribesmen is described in the official communication issued this evening as remaining calm, but "maintaining a serious character owing to the attitude of the Riffians, who daily are multiplying their local attacks and intensifying their propaganda."

The communication draws attention to the importance of the fact that the Riffians are organizing the territory they have occupied, which it declares shows the intention of Abd-el-Krim, the rebel leader, to annex these provinces.

The propaganda, the communication says, is having the effect in certain tribes of causing them to join the dissidents. Abd-el-Krim is credited with maintaining a strong hold over the confederated tribes of Northern Morocco, despite their weariness over the prolonged struggle and heavy losses and the hereditary quarrels between them.

After remarking the difficulty of understanding what Abd-el-Krim's present military plans are, although a great amount of information reaches Fez, the communication confirms that the Riffians are preoccupied with preparations to attack the Spanish and are collecting forces in the region of Adjir.

The communication asserts that numerous enemy contingents are harassing French posts unceasingly, many of them being attacked with rifles and cannon.
